Alerts follow a standard logic across all Siemens Energy sites







Alert Definition - Details SEE powered by SCoTTy 2.0

Order Confirmation Due Date Upcoming (- 2 Days)

Checks today's date is more than 7 (>=0)* days later than the document date of the PO

Order Confirmation Overdue (- 2 Days)

Checks today's date is more than 10 days (>= 2)* later than the document date of the PO

Order Confirmation Maintenance

Allows suppliers to update confirmed dates, earliest 14 days after PO creation

*new compared to SCCoTy 1.0

Due Date Upcoming in 7 Days

Checks if today's date is within 7 days of the delivery date from the schedule line

Due Date Upcoming

Checks if today's date is between 1 and 6 days away from the delivery date from the schedule line

Goods Receipt Overdue

Checks if today's date is after the delivery date from the schedule line of SAP delivery schedule

Confirmed Date Overdue

Checks if today's date is after the confirmed delivery date from supplier's order confirmation considering (= adding) the GR processing time

Confirmed Date Overdue SL

Checks if today's date is after the confirmed delivery date from the order confirmation + GR processing time. If no confirmation is available, it will use the delivery date from the schedule line

Both alerts

- ... Require a supplier answer
- ... Are sent repeatedly as long as Order Confirmation is not available
- ... Stop latest until 90 days after delivery date (or PO deletion)
- ... Are mutually exclusive.

Recommendation:

Activate both alerts or minimum Order confirmation overdue

Is only sent once (7 days after PO release)

Is sent acc. to local expediting schedule (if it's Mon – Fri = every day)

Recommendation: activate minimum Due Date Upcoming

This alert refers to the SE delivery date.

In case supplier does not send a PO confirmation or a deviating date this alert might consider an unconfirmed date

This alert refers to the supplier's confirmed delivery date adding the Goods receipt processing time from the material master

This alert combines alert 5+6, but sets priority on confirmed date. Only if there is no supplier's confirmation it considers the SE date.

<u>Recommendation</u>: activate minimum Confirmed Date Overdue (as this covers all possibilities to send a delivery overdue alert
